Traffic near City Centre Airport

Due to high volumes of pedestrian traffic and Park & Ride service, there will be intermittent road closures around the City Centre Airport all three days.

Yellowhead Trail

Expect major delays on Yellowhead Trail from 97 Street to St. Albert Trail on Saturday and Sunday afternoon. 107 Avenue, 111 Avenue and 137 Avenue are recommended alternate routes.

107 Street – 118 Avenue to Yellowhead Trail

Expect delays on 107 Street all three days from 118 Avenue to Yellowhead Trail.

121 Street – Kingsway to Yellowhead Trail

Northbound lanes will be closed to traffic on Saturday from 4:30 – 5:30 p.m. and on Sunday from 2:30 – 5:30 p.m. Limited southbound traffic will be available during this time.

109 Street – 120 Avenue to 123 Avenue

Local business access will be maintained from 120 Avenue only. High pedestrian movement in this area. Travel delays can be expected all three days.

123 Avenue – 107 Street to 109 Street

123 Avenue from 107 Street to 109 Street will be closed to westbound traffic. High pedestrian movement in this area.

Drop Off and Pickup Area

The public drop off and pickup area will be located on 120 Avenue between 107 Street and 109 Street. Paid public parking is available in the general area.

Taxi Stands

Two taxi stands will be located:

- West service road of 107 Street from 120 Avenue to 123 Avenue
- East side of 121 Street south of Bush Pilot Road (near the VIA rail terminal)

Parking

Paid public parking is available at a number of areas. For more information on parking please visit www.edmontonindy.com. There is NO PUBLIC PARKING in the surrounding residential neighbourhoods. Posted parking restrictions will be strictly enforced.

ETS Park & Ride Information

ETS has Park & Ride service to the event for all three days, from various sites around the city. Please see www.takeETS.com or call Transit Information at 311 for site locations and fares.

Security

Edmonton Police Service will be on hand throughout the event to ensure a safe and secure environment on the race site and in the surrounding communities.

Noise

Car noise will be heard in the communities near the race track starting at 7:30 a.m. until approximately 7 p.m. for three days. Noise levels will be monitored throughout the event.

Park & Ride service runs from Calder City Lot (124 Street/124 Avenue) to the race site.

Shuttle bus service runs continuously from City Hall (1 Sir Winston Churchill Square) to the race site.

Loop route runs around the City Centre Airport continuously during the event. (Kingsway/121 Street/Yellowhead Trail/107 Street/106 Street/Princess Elizabeth Avenue)

Special services start at
6:45 a.m. on Friday
6:30 a.m. on Saturday
6:30 a.m. on Sunday

Continuous service as needed from Calder and on City Hall shuttle.
Airport loop runs on a 5 minute frequency.

Service from the race site ends 45 minutes after the site closes each day.

Regular ETS transit fares apply on all other ETS service (bus/LRT/DATS).
